

## Guidelines for writing blog pieces for ourvoiceourrights.ie

January 2015

- Pieces should be between 500 and 800 words.
- Please suggest a title we might edit it but will try to use the one you prefer.
- Similarly, we may edit your piece for length etc but send back for your approval in such cases before publishing.
- Indicate clearly which Covenant article(s) or sub-section(s) you are referring to in your piece.
- If you are using a case-study or personal example, please ensure that anyone who is mentioned is happy with it.
- Please use spell-check before submitting. We use Irish/British-English spelling but it's not a big deal if you prefer to use US spelling.
- Try not to use acronyms, the full title is much clearer for non-insiders.
- Any images accompanying the piece should be sent to us as a separate image file (jpeg/TIFF/bmp etc) for upload.
- Please embed your hyperlinks in the text you want to use for it (like this <u>if I want to link to</u>
  <u>the FLAC site</u>) but if you are not sure how to do it, underline the text and put the desired link
  in brackets after it and we will do it for you.
- You can put a list of further links at the end in bullet points.
- Please include a short bio with just your name, title/organisation, main area of interest/work and any other <u>relevant</u> info. If you want to put in your direct contact info, please do but be aware that you may be risking spam or other contact.
- Please use sub-headings to break up your text where appropriate.
- Please credit any references to external sources you can use hyperlinks for this or footnotes. But not too many footnotes! They don't work well on a webpage.
- Legal or caselaw references you can use your preferred legal referencing system but please be clear about the names of cases/legal instruments/treaties you quote for example:
  - o UN Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights (2002) *Concluding Observations of the Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights: Ireland*, Geneva: OHCHR, p.2.
  - The Constitutional Review Group (1996) *Report of the Constitutional Review Group*, Dublin: Stationery Office, p.211.
  - o O'Donnell (a minor) & Others v South Dublin County Council [2007] IEHC 204
